

What a busy week the last week in Rotary has been with the first of two big events being the official opening of the ANZAC Centenary Walkway on Tuesday morning. There were approximately thirty five people in attendance and The Hon. Anna Burke MP had the honour to declare its official opening. There were presentations from Mayor Klisaris of the City of Monash; The President of the Waverley RSL, Mr Neil Slaughter; and the Rotary District 9810 Governor, Mr David Tolstrup. At the conclusion of the thirty minute ceremony, we enjoyed light refreshments in the Mount Waverley Community Centre. The RCMW is justifiably proud of the collective work of Paul Power, Geoff Logie Smith, Terry Roche and Phillip McKenzie in delivering this project from concept in July 2013 to completion two years later. Rather than describe the project in detail at this juncture, a comprehensive description of the project will be posted on the RCMW Website in due course. It is too important a success story to be hidden in the musings of the President. Later that same day, Geoff Logie Smith and I attended Ashwood Secondary College as guests for the Granting of Charter Ceremony to the Ashwood Secondary College Interact Club. This was an exciting night for the thirty five student members of the club. The raising of this Interact club is also a credit to the Rotary Club of Waverley for their work in sponsoring the initiative. This Interact club is now the fifth in District 9810 and it would certainly be exciting for the RCMW to facilitate the raising of an Interact club in our own patch.

The climax of the week was on Wednesday night with the visit of the DG, David Tolstrup and his wife Alison together with the AG, Tom Blair and his wife Suzanne. It was a relaxed evening and an opportunity to hear the DG's messages on the Rotary International front and also his strong desire for the clubs in the District to have a special focus in the 15/16 year on community education initiatives for Domestic Violence, men's health, and support to young driver safety awareness training.

This week we have Jeff Guy as guest speaker with regard to other life as a long term passenger on luxury ocean liners. Some people have the life! The week following is the first of four forums for 15/16. The venue and draft agenda will be provided at this week's meeting. Looking forward to seeing you then.



ANZAC CENTENARY WALKWAY

The new ANZAC Centenary Walkway in the grounds of the Mount Waverley Community Centre was officially opened on 4 August by the Hon. Anna Burke MP, Federal member for Chisholm.

The memorial walkway is a major project of the Mount Waverley Rotary Club, and the official opening was the culmination of the efforts of club members, Monash Council staff, and contractors over the last eighteen months. The walkway was funded by a grant made available under the ANZAC Centenary local grants program, and the opportunity to apply was brought to our attention by Anna Burke's office.

Club President Major Sean Darbyshire summarised the work undertaken and acknowledged those involved. The original concept was devised by Club Secretary Paul Power. Sean also spoke about his own family connection with World War 1, and his efforts to research this connection and publish this in the near future.

Anna Burke, in her speech to open the walkway, spoke of the bipartisan commitment to support the permanent recognition of our first ANZACS and the sacrifices made in World War 1. The grant to the Mount Waverley Rotary Club was the largest to any Rotary Club in Victoria.

In opening the walkway, Anna Burke noted that the walkway was a major undertaking and a fitting permanent memorial of which the community should be very proud.

City of Monash Mayor, Paul Klisaris, also recognised the major undertaking, and the efforts of Council staff and contractors in the construction process.

A moving speech by Neil Slaughter, President of the Glen Waverley RSL, and representing the State RSL, reminded all of what the ANZAC walkway memorial represents, and the need for all to reflect on this meaning whenever passing through the walkway. A fitting conclusion to his speech was his recitation of the Ode.

"They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old;

Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn.

At the going down of the sun and in the morning

We will remember them."

Lest We Forget

Our Rotary District Governor David Tolstrup concluded the formal proceedings by giving an overview of the work Rotary seeks to do in local communities. While this ANZAC Centenary Walkway is one major example of projects Rotary embarks on, David spoke of the many other programs and projects, Youth Services and Community Services that Rotary is involved in locally and world wide.
