The Australian Synchrotron is a world-class science research facility located in the South-East Melbourne suburb of Clayton. We regularly receive interest from groups such as yourselves for visits to come and see what happens here at the Synchrotron, but are unable to routinely offer such groups a private tour. To meet this interest, we have decided to hold the following public access event where your members will be able to come along and learn a little of what takes place at the Synchrotron and how it impacts all our lives. Mindful of monthly meeting schedules, we would like to offer you early advice of the date and time of this unique opportunity, in order for you to discuss this at your November meetings. The event is free, but booking will be essential. Numbers are limited to 330 per session. Details of what will be on offer are as follows:

"Crystallography: Making matters crystal clear" Australian Synchrotron - Speakers Series 2014. Thursday 11 December, 10am or 2pm (2 hour event)

Crystallography is the foremost technique for working out the molecular structure of almost anything, and helps explain why matter behaves the way it does. It has a long and illustrious history and has paved the way for many huge advances in human life. For example it has revealed the structure of DNA, helped design effective medicines and even strengthened the wings of planes! Never heard of it? Don't worry, not many people have. However there are three big reasons the Australian Synchrotron would like to change that at our next Speakers Series event "Crystallography: Making matters crystal clear":

- 1) Australia has contributed significantly to crystallography which is used every hour worldwide,
- 2) 2014 is the International Year of Crystallography, and
- 3) along with the Bragg Institute at ANSTO, we're pretty good at it!

The 2-hour event will explain in an easy-to-understand presentation how the Australian Synchrotron provides x-ray crystallography techniques for Australian industrial and scientific researchers to help improve all of our lives. It will also offer a viewing of the synchrotron machine and beamlines where the scientists bring the technique to life.

This is a free event. Bookings are essential.

Date: Thursday, 11 December 2014

Two session options available (each include a tour):

10:00 – 12:00 or 14:00 – 16:00

Please note:

The tour requires participants to be capable of walking unaided for at least 25 minutes. The tour route has a concrete floor with very limited seating along the way. There are 2 flights of stairs, but a lift is available.

The tour is optional: Please indicate on your reservation if you wish to take the walking tour by selecting the appropriate ticket type. Everyone attending the tour will need to adhere to the attached safety information. The tour on 11 December will not include the storage ring or injection system area. Free parking is available onsite. Light refreshment will be available at the onsite Synchrotron staff cafe 'The Kitchen Synch' at visitor's own expense.
