

I want to extend a very big thank you to all members who assisted in every way to make this project a success. To those who donated goods and we had plenty, to those who assisted in selling on the day and especially to Terry Roche and Roger Mould whose help was invaluable and the project could not run without the enormous input from these members.

My grateful thanks also goes to the R.C. of Oakleigh for allotting 4 car spaces from which to sell and a very special thanks to P.P. Ian Phelan of the Oakleigh club, who gave an afternoon of his time and expertise in testing many of the electrical items ensuring their safety and usability.

As I promised, 20% of the proceeds will be given to Oakleigh for their help and assistance. Finally, I can advise that we exceeded all expectations and raised a grand total of **\$1,142.55**. Hopefully, we will run this event again next year as long as we are able to have space at the Oakleigh market.
