Dear Rhonda McKenzie

The Foundation for Homeless Youth has now completed negotiations with the Department of Human Services and is holding recovered funds of up to \$850,000.

The FHY has until now provided supported housing for homeless youth. I am proud of our achievements in this regard. Although disappointed I can confirm that the Board is of the unanimous view that it is now time to wind-up the operations of the Foundation.

All homes still operate as homes for homeless youth or other disadvantaged persons, largely sole parents with families through DHS.

The Board will call a meeting in early 2015 to ask members to pass a resolution to effect the dissolution of the Foundation.

The Board has given considerable thought to how the surplus assets should be distributed, and has obtained legal advice as a result of which the Board is not in a position to be able to distribute the assets to the founding Rotary Club members.

I find this situation disappointing but am satisfied that the legal situation is quite clear in this regard.

As a consequence of this advice the Board is seeking Requests for Submissions from other organisations which will use the funds for the same purposes for which the Foundation was established – providing medium to long-term accommodation for homeless youth in Victoria – and in that way, the legacy of the Foundation and the Rotary Clubs which founded it will continue.

The Board will bring the final decision as to which organisation/s should receive a distribution of assets upon winding up to the Members at the meeting in early 2015.

We will continue to keep you informed.


