VOCATIONAL SERVICE - VicPol MENTORING PROJECT

I met with Senior Sergeant Yvonne Upton on Monday. The project to repurpose bicycles handed in to the police is progressing well. The VicPol senior command has approved the proposal and we are just waiting for VicPol property division to sign off (which is just a formality but nevertheless a hold up).

Meanwhile, Yvonne has arranged to meet with the Rotary Club of Pascoe Vale on 15 March to explain the project and seek their involvement in the repair and clean up of bicycles and the identification of needy people and families to receive the bicycles. She has also recruited 3 other police officers who wish to be involved in the project.

I have been invited to the police graduation ceremony on 12 May at the Police Academy. I shall be there with Yvonne and she's quite chuffed as she graduated from the Academy on same date in 1988.

Yvonne was the Divisional Commander for the northern region on the day the plane crashed into DFO at Essendon Airport. She was onsite 4 minutes after the crash and was the first emergency services person there. She immediately set about setting up the inner and outer perimeters of the crime scene and blocking off traffic on the Tullamarine and Calder freeways. She said that there were seven explosions after the crash, as fuel tanks (of the plane and a car) and other components blew up over the next 2 hours. Once the fire was extinguished and the site was safe she supervised the recovery of the victims' bodies. She then met with the Coroner for a briefing. It turned into a 12 hour work day for her. She described it as a once in a career event. She then added once is enough.

We are dealing with quite a remarkable person and I'm so pleased that she credits the mentoring program as a huge influence in the way she does things now compared to 6 months ago.

Whilst we wait, Fidelcia has been thriving in Koala Ward, eating everything put in front of her and slowly gaining weight and getting stronger. She is sitting up for longer periods, playing and interacting with visitors with smiles and high fives. She has had a steady stream of visitors from the Timorese community, our interpreters and from home host, Liz Olie. Yesterday, Norm Casey and I visited her and she was somewhat intrigued with all the white hair. If you can drop in to

see her and Hernania, please do so. Hernania is quickly learning some English, has access to a translation app, and hand signals work wonders.

Next week I will be interstate from Wed 8 Mar to Sun 12 Mar incl and, during that time, Norm Casey will undertake my D9810 ROMAC Chair duties.
